 will is that she shall have these xxij Lync and a Bull or alls Chertsey parsonage of money wether
 she will take. Item I give and bequeath unto John my sonne Twentie pound in money or good. Item
 I give and bequeath unto Johne my daughter Twentie pound in money or good. Item I give and bequeath
 unto willm my sonne Twentie pound in money or good. Item I give and bequeath unto my two sonnes
 John and willm as followeth. Firste to willm my sonne my beste garret and my best Coate.
 Item I give and bequeath to John my sonne my seconde Garret and my Batten Doublet. The residue
 of my apparell to be divided indifferentlie betwix them. Item I will that Margaret my wife
 shal be Custodye of my Cochet of silver being gilted wether Twentie ounces so longe as she liveth
 and after her decease I give of to willm my sonne. Item I give and bequeath my brother Richarde
 two sonnes Thomas and John Exor Challunge Dughe to have a pore. Item I give and bequeath the
 residue of my good to bequeste my debtes being paid and my funerally discharged to be indifferentlie
 divided betwix Margaret my wife and John my sonne willm my sonne and John my daughter
 at the discretion of my overseers. Except such beddinge and Marryng ware or lymyns wether by brass
 and Allice wether my wife was possessor of before I married her that I will she shall have
 at her discretion. And unto the execution of this my last will and testament I ordaine to substitute
 and appointe Margaret my wife and willm both my sonne my executor to see this my last
 will and Testament performed. Item I ordaine to substitute and appointe willm my sonne
 and Richarde Powell gent overseers unto this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof
 I have hereunto putt my hande and Scale the daye and yere above written. This beinge
 witness wherof names are here subscribed, Richarde Powell merchant Thomas Cylter Richarde
 both glouer Thomas Cotte John hple glouer, Edmunde beuf clerk

In da nomine Amen I John Bobbet of Blaxsalle in the Countie of Suffolke and Justice
 of peace beinge by godly sufferance and grace sike in bodye but of good and perfect remembrance
 blessed be god therfore, the xxvjth daye of December in the yere of our Lorde God 1576 and
 in the yere of the raigne of our most dread sovereigne ladye Elizabeth by the Grace of God
 of Englande, France and Irelande Queene Defender of the faith etc the xxvjth daye of December
 I have made this my last will and Testament wherby I doe will and bequeath unto all
 these wills and Testaments by me hereunto made in manner and forme followinge. Firste I doe
 give and bequeath my soule unto god the most blessed and holye Trinity father sonne
 and the holie goste whome I most humbly beseech to receive my soule into the state of hevenly
 and Everlastinge blissents, and in the said state to continue forever. And my bodye I doe bequeath
 unto the church from whence I came willinge my Executors to cause the same to be buried wether in the church
 of Blaxsalle aforesaid in the accustomed place appointed for the buriall of the Deade in such
 decent maner as they shall thinke beste. Item I give to the poor of the parische of Little Cleeve
 Twentie Shillings to be paid immediatly after my decease. Item I give to the poor of the Towne of
 Mistale xxij shillings to be paid wether in one yere after my decease I give unto the Mayor, Councillors
 and the poore of the Towne of Cleeve Twentie Shillings to be paid one yere after my decease. Item I give to the poore of the Towne of

my said Executors shall refuse this to be done. Then I will that my M^r Thomas Sanderson shall my said
Executor to see this my last will expressed in all things as my trust is in him In witness whereof
to this my present last will and Testaments touching on ffour sheets of paper I have sette my
hande subscribing my name in the presence of Walter Osborne, Robert Palmer, William Palmer, John Barber
and others.

The laste daye of Maye in the year of our lordes God 1576 I John
Floode of the County of Essex gent beinge of godly remembrance thanks be to god doe
ordaine and make this my laste will and Testaments in manner and forme followinge that is to say. First
I commaunde my soule into the hande of almyghty god, and my bodye to the earth from whence I came to be
buried in the parish church of St^{an}ton in the county of Essex please god to call me, or els if I dye within the liberties of the said
towne I will that yt shalbe buried in the church of St^{an}ton in the parish of St^{an}ton in the county of Essex and as touching
my worldlye goodes I will and bequethe them as hereafter shalbe specified. Item I geve to Andrew my
nephew of good and lawfull mouey of Eng^{lan}de, also I geve to the said Andrew ffour shillings p^{ro}vided
one bruyce leade, remaininge with my farmer of Danywell hall. Also I geve unto my nephew
with the said Andrew belonginge to him Doves for his use for me. And all my householde stuffe wherof I
be possessor hereafter excepted. Item more I geve unto the said Andrew my newe out Coate of plate
with the furniture that belongeth to yt. And one hurquebus with a mirror, flasket and tushoboy.
And with legarys and giftes I have willed and geuen her p^{ro}pon tendron, that the said Andrew my
nephew shalbe not p^{ro}vide after my decease to open any of my Chestes or any Deste or other trauyse to be
allred any thinge or thinge touching in hym before my Executor hathy chose and oute looked for same
for if he doe then I will her legarys and giftes to be void, and that the said Andrew my nephew
to dispose as he thinketh good. Item I geve to Thomas Sanderson gent my brackeyn in lince, my gowne
gowne furred thoroughout with lince furred with Ermye and lince with lince and Buttons. Item more I geve
to him my Ermye double yarded with lince. Item I geve to the said Thomas of my sister Eluor beards
dentist denture of Ermye y^{et} best some excepted unto whom I do geue my remayn of Ermye with my scale
of Ermye furred with lince, wherof I will shalbe paid to whome one of the said
Children as they shalbe accomplishe their severall ages of xijth years, and if it shalbe fortune any of them
to decease this my last will before they come to the full age of xijth years, then I will that parte to
remayne to them the bylonge. Item I geve to Richard Smyth gent my brother in lince my
Ermye furred thoroughout with lince and lince with lince. Item I geve to my sister his
nephew two dics of myntell. Item I geve to her children to w^home one of them w^ho a p^{ro}vide of some
excepted unto whom I geve a yarde of Ermye with a scale of y^{et} best. Item I will shalbe paid to whome one of the said
Children as they shalbe accomplishe their severall ages of xijth years. And if it shalbe fortune any of them
to decease this my last will before they come to the full age of xijth years, then I will that parte to
remayne to them the bylonge. Item I geve
unto my sister Catharine M^{rs} another by wiche of Edmund M^{rs} gent the some of xxth of
lawfull mouey of Eng^{lan}de to be paid to her within one month after my decease. Item I geve to my
Nephew James Sanderson my Coppy holden lince in myntell called Cuttes to him and to his heirs
if he live unto thage of xijth years p^{ro}pon tendron that he dothe paye or cause to be paid unto
any of his two Sisters Elizabeth and Anne, in the paye of god and lawfull mouey of Eng^{lan}de
at whatt tyme as the said James shalbe come to his full age of xijth years. And if the said James
shalbe fortune to decease this my last will before he cometh to the full age of xijth years then I
will the said Coppy holden lince and the Surrender to be geuen by me shalbe paid and be unto
the said Elizabeth and Anne and their heirs by equall moieties to be divided and appoynted betw^{en}
them p^{ro}pon their admisson to the same by the good discreti^{on} of the bymynge of the mayntell of the
said lince be holden. And of it I do geve my full will and mynde that
