yeare of the reigne of our Sovereigne Lord King Charles the second over
England &c. Annoq. Dni One thousand six hundred eighty five I Richard
Bobbott of Mirkell. Cretch in the Countie of Somersett Alexander being out
and weak in body but of perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) doe make
and ordaine this my last Will and Testament in manner and forme following
first I commend my soule into the hands of almighty God who gave it
me and my body I commit to the earth from whence it came to be decently
buried. Inp. I give and bequeath unto John Daker the elder of
Doridwater in the said Countie one third parte of m and to a Crow Vessel
or Cath commonly called the William and Richard of Doridwater and
wherof hee now hath Master and of m and to one third parte of all the
Masse Gards Sailes Nethers Cables Boate stiffe Oares and other Earthing
Materials and things therunto belonging Also I give and bequeath unto
the said John Daker all such debts as are due and owing from the said John
Daker to me or David Will or other wise Also I give and bequeath unto
Robert Walsh the younger sonne of Robert Walsh the elder of
Cauntou my Godson the sume of fivie pounds of lawfull money of England
to be paid unto his Uncle Richard Snow for the use of my said Godson
within three yeares after my decease Also I give and bequeath unto Sarah
Deeds daughter of Alexander Deeds of Doridwater my Goddaughter
fivie pounds of lawfull money of England to be paid within two yeares
after my decease Also I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Starkey my
Goddaughter daughter of Thomas Starkey of Doridwater if shee be
living three pounds of lawfull money of England And I give to my God
daughter Margaret Davies als Welchman daughter of John Davies
als Welchman the sume of three pounds of lawfull money of England.
the said two last mentioned Legacies to be paid within three yeares next
after my decease Also I give to Joane Bobbott daughter of Uncle
Richard Bobbott deceased fiftie shillings of lawfull English money to be
paid her within one yeare after my decease Also I give unto Thomas
Curreant of Oldcombe in the Countie of Devon and unto the said Richard
Daker of Doridwater and unto his now Wife and unto Thomas Morgan
of Dinton hexty in the Countie of Glamorgan in Wales twenty
shillings apert to buy each of them a Watt Also I give unto Edith Shilly
my Servant the sume of fivie pounds to be paid her within one yeare after
my decease Also I give and bequeath unto the Sonne of James Diffin late
of Cauntou deceased if hee be living the sume of fivie pounds and the same
to remaine in the hands of my Executor hereinafter named to be by him
employed and improved for the good and benefitt of my said Godson
Diffin during his minority) and to be paid unto him with the profits thereof
made at his age of one and twenty yeares Also I give unto the Poore of
the said Parish of Mirkell Cretch the sume of fivie pounds of lawfull
money of England and the same to be distributed to such Poore People as
my Executor shall thinke fitt Lastly all the rest of my Lands Tenements
Goods

of lawfull money of England
Also I give unto John Borge
my Servant the sume of fivie
pounds of lawfull money of England
to be paid within three yeares after
my decease

the parties above named to whom the Premises are devised doe and
shall refuse or neglect to pay the summe of Twenty pounds of lawfull
money of England unto my said Sonne William within one year next
after my decease Then I give and devise the said Premises immediately
after the determination of my said Wifes Estate therein above limited
unto my said Sonne William and the Heires of his body and for default
of such Heires to my right Heires as aforesaid Item I give and
bequeath unto Sarah my daughter the summe of Twelve p^ount and to
every of her Children now living to wit John William Henry Margarette
