Every American with immigrant ancestors needs the "Passenger and Immigration List Index: 2003 edition, 1500s-1900s" — especially for those seeking ancestors prior to the 1820s. Updated for 2003, this data set contains listings of approximately 4,215,000 individuals who arrived in United States and Canadian ports from the 1500s through the 1900s.

Updated annually, the "Passenger and Immigration Lists Index" was compiled by P. William Filby and published by Gale Research. This resource includes individuals included in the "Index" and all supplements through the year 2003.

While researching passenger lists can often be tedious and difficult, this data set makes finding information on your immigrant ancestors easier than ever. Each entry has been indexed by name and is searchable by keyword. The "Genealogical Journal" hailed the printed version of the "Passenger and Immigration List Index" as "one of the greatest contributions to the genealogical literature in the last decade."
