The limits of age for military service in these times were 16 and 60, but we find in some of these lists, as Hinderclay and other places, the ages of men over 60 are noted against their names which looks as if the instructions were to include the older men. The following return is from Harleian M.S. No 366, fol. 50-72 at the British Museum. It appears to refer to the year 1584.
