In the name of god amen: the xij [12th]
dae of Marche in the yeare of ou[r] lorde god one
thousande five hyndred eightie and in the xxij [22nd] yeare
of the reigne of ou[r] Sovereigne ladie Elizabeth by the
grace of god alm[ightie] I **Joh[a]n[nis] Bobbet** of holleslie in the
countie of Suff[olk] and dioc[es]e of Norwiche thanks be
unto almightie god being of hole minde and perfecte
remembrance doe ordaine and make this my present last
will and testament in manner and forme following First
I commit my Soule into the handes of almightie god and my
bodie to the earth from where it came and as p[]
my wordlie goodes I give and bequeath them in manner
and forme following: Item I give and bequeathe unto
Tomas my sonne the sume of five poundes of lawfull
english money to be paid unto the said **Tomas** within
one yeare nexte after my decease:/Item I give
unto **Rose** my daughter the sume of fyve poundes to
be paid unto the said **Rose** when she shall accomplish
the age of xvj [26] yeares./Item I will that if it shall
fortune my said daughter **Rose** to departe this present
worlde before she shall accomplish her said age of
xvj [26] yearers, then I will her said five poundes to
be equallie divided amongst the rest of her brethren the
brethen having parte and parte like./All the residue of my
goodes corne cattall money debtes and househole stuff
unbequeathed I give and bequeathe them unto **Margaret**
my wief **Daniell** my sone **Lyonell** my sone **Thomas**
my sone and **John**]my sonne equallie to be divided
amongst them parte and parte like which said **Thomas** and
Joh[a]n[nis]] I doe make myn[e] Executors in whome I doe
[] all my truste to [] this my last will trulie
[]med these being witnesses **John Sturgin Thomas**
Bad] **Henrie Parne**[] and **Humfrie Rob**[] .
